Venue

Travel by Public Transport

The closest train station to the University is Huddersfield Train Station. The closest major airport to the University is Manchester International Airport, which connects with most international cities.

Travel by Car

From the M1 to Queensgate, Huddersfield

Exit the M1 at junction 38. At the roundabout take the second exit onto the A637 (signposted Huddersfield) for approximately 6 miles. At the third roundabout take the first exit onto the A642. On the approach to Huddersfield this turns into the A629. As you approach Huddersfield Town Centre, drive past Lidl supermarket on your left through two sets of traffic lights and up to the roundabout (University on your left hand side). Take the first exit at the roundabout and the entrance to the Queensgate car park is approximately 100 yards on the left.

From the M62 to Queensgate, Huddersfield

Please note there are three junctions off the M62 to Huddersfield. We have suggested Jct 25 as the easiest to find us. Exit the M62 at Junction 25. Take the A644 towards Huddersfield and follow this road for approximately 1 mile. At the roundabout take the second exit (A62 Leeds Road). Proceed along the A62 towards Huddersfield following signs for the John Smith's Stadium. After approximately 2.5 miles you will pass the Leeds Road retail park on your left. Continue along the A62. At the next set of lights turn left onto Southgate, passing the Sports Centre on your left. Get into the middle lane, following the signs for the University. You will pass Sainsbury's on your left, keep right at the fork and go straight across the roundabout, following signs for the Ring Road. The entrance to the Queensgate car park will be approximately 100 yards on the left.

If you will be using a satellite navigation system, please use postcode HD1 3DH. The sat nav will bring you to the University but please follow the instructions above to get you to the correct car park.

Car Parking

There is a limited amount of car parking available on our Queensgate campus which is allocated on a first come first served basis. Accessible parking is available for blue badge holders.
