**Venue:** Sheffield Hallam University. Faculty of Health and Wellbeing, Collegiate Campus  
Robert Winston Building, 11-15 Broomhall Road, Sheffield. S10 2DN (Sat Nav postcode)  
The meeting will take place in Room F514, (located on the 5th Floor of the Robert Winston  
Building (see attached map – building 21)

**Travel:** Driving - From junction 33 of the M1, follow signs for A630 Sheffield City Centre.  
Continue on the A630 until the dual carriageway ends at a large roundabout with traffic  
signals (Park Square). Take the third exit from the roundabout signposted A61  
Chesterfield. Go straight ahead following the road in front of the railway station. Take the  
middle lane signed A61 Ring Road.

Follow the road to the right onto St. Mary's Road. Travel straight ahead. At Moor Street roundabout turn left signposted A625 Castleton onto Ecclesall Road. Collegiate Campus is approximately 750 metres (1/2 mile) down Ecclesall Road on the right shortly after the Marks & Spencer store.

Sheffield's National coach service for long distance travel is comprehensive and efficient. Its central pick up and terminal point is at the Transport Interchange.

Regular inter-city services operate between Sheffield and other main line towns and cities. London is two-and-a-half hours away by train, Manchester, Leeds and Birmingham one hour and Edinburgh four hours.

Sheffield's Midland Station is just a two minute walk away from our City Campus and the nearby Transport Interchange links you directly to our other campus at Collegiate Campus (10 minutes by taxi).
