Effects of Caring/Stress

Stress is part of everyday life, and for many carers can be a major factor affecting their health.

- Mental symptoms can include anxiety, anger, depression, lack of appetite, sleeplessness, crying often, tiredness and difficulty concentrating
- Physical symptoms can include chest pains, cramps, muscle spasms, chest pains, dizziness, restlessness, nervous twitches and breathlessness







Effects of Caring/Stress

 Physical symptoms can include chest pains, cramps, muscle spasms, chest pains, dizziness, restlessness, nervous twitches and breathlessness

In the long-term, some of these stress symptoms can affect your health — putting you at risk of high blood pressure, which can lead to more serious health conditions.

This performance project focuses on the idea of duologue and objects that represent the duologue in an iconic way produced by the over 60's theatre group, Encore Theatre Company






